



Summertime Fun at MSNV

MSNV's camp runs for 8 weeks, from June 16th to August 8th. We offer programs for ages three through nine at our 3- acre Annandale campus near the George Mason Regional Library.

Our fun-filled summer of discovery and creativity helps children grow as they explore, make friends, and learn new skills. We are offering a variety of programs that fits the needs and interests of preschoolers through third graders. Early morning and afternoon extended day is available to all campers.

The Primary camp is a mixed-age group, one of the trademarks of Montessori. Children age 3, 4 and 5 start the day in our Primary program beginning at 9:00 and ending at noon. (Children must be 3 by the day they begin camp).

Three and four year olds who remain for a longer day join the extended day room after lunch for a rest time followed by fun afternoon activities until 5:45 pm. Five-year-olds have the option of continuing with their activities until 3:00, when they may either go home or join afternoon extended day.

The Elementary camp program (mixed ages also) is from 9:00 to 3:00. Children staying beyond 3:00 will join afternoon extended day which ends at 5:45 pm. The final week of Elementary camp is reserved for students who will be entering our elementary program in the fall.

Daily nutritious snacks are provided in the morning and again, after 3:00. Campers bring their own lunch. In addition to the themed weekly programs (see separate flyer), campers enjoy various special activities during certain weeks including gymnastics, dance/creative movement, and music. Outdoor time on our spacious, shaded playground is a part of each day, both in the morning and in the afternoon. Campers also enjoy working in our Montessori garden and taking nature hikes in the adjoining Indian Run Stream Valley Park.
