

# STANDARDS OF DRIVING CONDUCT

Dear Parents,

Please read the Bylaws and Parent and Student Handbook for MSNV carefully. It is imperative that you understand and abide by the traffic laws set by the school and by Virginia and Fairfax in the neighborhoods surrounding MSNV. These standards outlined below were designed to protect the safety of all citizens and to maintain a positive relationship with the neighborhood to ensure the future of our school.

## Driving Conduct in MSNV Neighborhood:

- Drive 25 miles per hour
- Come to a full stop at all stop signs (no rolling stop)
- Do not block driveways or intersections while in carpool line (allow a minimum of 10 feet around driveways)
- Use extreme caution around pedestrians
- Obey school bus laws
- When possible, stop and allow neighbors to back out of their driveway)

## Driving Conduct on MSNV Grounds:

- Follow safe driving guidelines established in MSNV Handbook for Students and Parents
- Pedestrians have right of way
- Do not pass another car in carpool line (driving down left side of driveways)
- Do not leave unattended car in carpool line
- Do not park on the street during regular school operations
- If you double park, use your carpool sign to identify your car. Write your ID information on the board inside the school.
- Cars coming down the driveway have the right of way. Cars going up must yield.

Failure to abide by these standards directly affects our status as a cooperative school in the community and, more importantly, creates safety hazards that may endanger lives.

I will communicate this information with anyone who drops off or picks up my child/children at MSNV.
